

**INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR PERSONS SUBMITTING THE INQUIRIES TO THE OFFICE OF COMPETITION  
AND CONSUMER PROTECTION**

In accordance with Article 13 (1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), we inform you that:

<b>Purposes of personal data processing and legal basis</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>to handle a case in accordance with applicable laws on the basis of a legal obligation to which the controller is subject, and in order to perform tasks carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of public authority entrusted to the controller (Article 6 (1) (c) and (e) of the GDPR), in particular on the basis of Article 31 of the Act on Competition and Consumer Protection of 16 February 2007. The specific legal basis for processing personal data depends on the nature of the case.</li><li>fulfilling the obligation to archive documents pursuant to Article 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR in connection with Article 5 (1) (2) of the Act of 14 July 1983 on national archival resources and archives</li></ul>
<b>Information about recipients of personal data</b>	Personal data may be shared with entities that provide IT, postal and courier services to the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection. Your personal data may be shared with authorities authorised under common law, but they are not recipients of data within the meaning of the provisions of the GDPR.
<b>Personal data retention period</b>	The retention period of personal data is regulated by UOKiK's clerical instruction drawn up in accordance with the Act of 14 July 1983 on national archival resources and archives in accordance with which that period shall be 5 years from the end of the year when the case concerned was completed.
<b>Rights of data subject</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>right to access and obtain copies of the data</li><li>right to rectification of your personal data</li><li>right to erasure of your personal data</li><li>right to restrict processing of your personal data</li><li>right to object to processing of your personal data</li><li>right to file a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office</li></ul>
<b>Information about the voluntariness of providing personal data or obligation to provide them</b>	Provision of personal data for the purpose of submitting an inquiry is voluntary. In order for the Data Controller to respond to your inquiry, it is necessary to provide the personal data to which the response should be sent.
